Class 2A : Natural Animal Feeds **Senior 80cm Show Jumping Teams**
(All team members are automatically entered in Class 2B)

Class 2B: Natural Animal Feeds **Senior 80cm Show Jumping individuals .**

Class 3A: Natural Animal Feeds **Senior 90cm Show Jumping Teams**
(All team members are automatically entered in Class 3B)

Class 3B: Natural Animal Feeds **Senior 90cm Show Jumping individuals**

Class 4A: Natural Animal Feeds **Mixed 100cm Show Jumping Teams**
(All team members are automatically entered in Class 4B)

Class 4B: Natural Animal Feeds **Mixed 100cm Show Jumping individuals**

Class 5A: Natural Animal Feeds **Mixed 110cm Show Jumping individuals.**

Class 9: London & SE 80cm Show Jumping Teams.
4 riders in the team with any combination of seniors & juniors.

Class 10: Natural Animal Feeds **Senior Style Jumping Teams**
4 riders : 2 x 75cm style & 2 x 85cm Style.
(All team members automatically entered in Classes 10B or 10C)

Class 10B: Natural Animal Feeds **Senior 75cm Style Jumping individuals**

Class 10C: Natural Animal Feeds **Senior 85cm Style Jumping individuals**

Vaccination Rules.

Original vaccination and / or passports must be submitted to the Secretary on the day on collection of numbers for each horse before taking part in the competition. Passports will be checked & must be collected before you go home. Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current 2019 BRC Handbook.

Protective Headwear Rules.

Correct riding attire must be worn at all times. When mounted at any BRC event whether competing or not 'Protective Headwear' must be worn & fastened under the chin is mandatory.

All hats must have the aqua hat tag visible with either BRC, PC or BE logos. Failure to do so will incur elimination.

All protective headwear can be checked at the Area 6 competitions and tagged before competing if you have not got the aqua tag.
