BRC AREA 6

London & South East Horse Trials Qualifiers run in conjunction with the Area 6 National Championship qualifiers on Sunday 26th May at Snowball Farm.

Where the same rider and horse is competing in both the National BRC 80 & LSE Qualifier, please enter Class 4a (Senior) as appropriate on the official entry form. All team entries for National 80 qualifier will automatically be entered into the L&SE qualifier unless the Team Manager advises otherwise. The team members will only compete once and their score will count towards both qualifiers.

There are no individual qualification places for L&SE horse trials.

L&SE Championships will be run at Snowball Farm in October 2019.

SNOWBALL FARM Vaccination Rules.

Require vaccinations to be no more than 6 months ago and not within the last 6 days before the Horse trials.

Original vaccination and / or passports must be submitted to the Secretary on the day on collection of numbers for each horse before taking part in the competition.

Passports will be checked & must be collected before you go home.

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current 2019 BRC Handbook.

XC Course can be walked from 3pm Friday 24th May. But SJ course is subject to change on Sunday morning – please check !!. There is a separate HT competition on Saturday 25th May.

HELPERS NEEDED. OBHRC members can not compete unless the club can provide helpers on the day. Entries will not be accepted.

One helper needed per team and/or group of 3 / 4 individuals.

Protective Headwear Rules.

Correct riding attire must be worn at all times. When mounted at any BRC event whether competing or not ‘ Protective Headwear ‘ must be worn & fastened under the chin is mandatory .

All hats must have the aqua hat tag visible with either BRC, PC or BE logos. Failure to do so will incur elimination.

All protective headwear can be checked at the Area 6 competitions and tagged before competing if you have not got the aqua tag.

Important: For Cross- Country Phase.

Jockey Skull complying with the BRC standards must be worn. This must not have a peak, any peak type of extensions or noticeable protuberances above the eyes or in front and should have an even round or elliptical shape with smooth or lightly abrasive surface. A removable hat cover with a light flexible peak may be used if required.

Body Protectors

A body protector is obligatory in all cross country competitions and is strongly recommended in show jumping competitions. A BETA Level 3 displaying either a Purple 2009 label or Blue 2018 label must be worn. Body protectors should be fitted and worn as per the manufacturer’s instructions. The up to date BETA list of body protectors can be obtained from www.beta-uk.org **Riders wearing Exo Body Cage** with a 2000 purple label will be permitted.

The competitors must inform the secretary at all events.

Air Jackets

If a rider chooses to wear an airbag style body protector it must be worn over a permitted BETA Level 3 (purple label) body protector and if activated, must be deflated or removed before continuing. Hybrid Air-Jackets and blouson style air jackets are permitted. It is recommended that body protectors are replaced once they are more than 5 years old.

Medical armbands:

Medical armbands are mandatory for any type of cross-country competition. These must be worn on the arm and not on the leg. They should be filled in with the relevant competitor’s details. Checks will be carried in the collecting ring.
