The cost covers:

- Instruction
- Breakfasts, lunches, soft drinks and Friday supper. Please let us know any special dietary requirements. Saturday supper is not included in the overall cost and is to be paid separately as we will dine in a local pub.
- Tea and coffee throughout the day.
- Stabling includes straw bedding.

You need to bring:

Your own alcoholic beverages or favourite drinks.

Your own hay, hay nets, and hard feed. Your morning hard feeds need to be pre-mixed and portioned out into plastic bags as the horses are all fed together early by the yard manager. They will need to be left outside each stable.

If you use shavings or bedding other than straw please let us know in advance, so that a stable can be cleared ready for you. **You must then clear out your stable before leaving.**

Mucking out forks and stable equipment. The stables have automatic water feeders but you may prefer to bring your own water bucket.

Your own portable saddle rack which will be kept in a lockable tack room.

Back protector, skull cap and medical armband for cross country. Any riding hats should be tagged with the new official aqua official 2018 tag. This can be done by BE, PC or BRC.

Extra points:

Sorry, no dogs as Lesley has dogs at the farm.

Smoking is prohibited, apart from in the camping area.
