Come & join in a morning of Trec – type activities for members and invited guests.

No activity is obligatory. No one will get eliminated. Missing an activity just means zero points for that activity.

No fancy horse or pony required. No fancy riding clothes needed.

You should wear Hi-viz jacket or waistcoat. Reflectors on your horses to be safe riding out on the lanes. Riding Hats to be BRC 2016 Standard are obligatory. See website for riding Hat rules.

Aim: To have fun with your horse / pony practising & testing skills you might find out hacking.

Format: Our Fun Trec will comprise of three phases:

Mini – orienteering **

Control of paces

Numbered Obstacle course (10 elements)

Start: First pair of riders start at 10.00am

Entries: Name of rider and horse / pony and if you are travelling on your own. Please email or text a contact number in case of an emergency.

Times : Friday 6th April - Will be on club website www.obhrc.org.uk and the OBHRC members' only and open face book page.

Prizes: Lovely Rosettes 1st – 8th place, plus Special rosettes to all riders. The OBHRC member who wins the most points overall from the Spring & or Autumn Trec is presented with beautiful Coney Spurs Trophy at the AGM.

Note: As this is a members' activity there will not be any looos or catered refreshments.

** A short timed hack over a measured distance, on local lanes & off –road & bridleway. This requires very basic map reading skills and should ideally be ridden at rates notified in advance for walk, trot and canter.

Hi-viz waistcoat or jacket and mobile phone is advised as the lanes are wooded in places.

Winner and placings will be awarded on the total individual points scored. Points will be adapted from the British Trec Rules and awarded for each obstacle + control of paces+ orienteering.
