Past Events: Fun Trec

The Fun Trec had to be cancelled on the 8th April due to water logged ground and then on 28th April due to lack of entries.

Maybe it would be useful if we organised a Trec training day for members to learn more about this competition and practice some of the types of obstacle used.

There is also a similar competition – Versatile Horse – includes a dressage instead of the orienteering

Fun Trec - Explained

This is a different type of competition which includes skills and agility type obstacles to be completed as accurately as possible within a time set for each obstacle, with marks awarded for completion.

Control of Paces: How slow can your horse canter along a set distance and fast is the walk back.

There is usually ride out on lanes and bridleways with a set time to complete with

marks given or lost depending on how near you get to the bogey time set for the distance of the ride.

Look out for a training date to follow soon.

The Club Field

From early May onwards until late September training and competitions will be at the field. Show jumps will be laid out as a course for jumping training, the dressage arena will be set out for test practicing & there will be other roped rings for flatwork lessons or pole & gymnastic exercises.

Open Jumping & Showing Show

Sunday 13th May – Club field, Hog Lane, Ashley Green.

This is a combined show as we lost the Showing show on Good Friday due to the field being water logged.

We have two Jumping rings.

Ring 1 Clear round at 65 -70cm, with a max of 30 tickets only.

Genuine Novice – 70cm & no Spreads. Novice 80cm, Intermediate 85cm & Open 90cm. Novelty class if time permits. There will be separate jump offs & placings for horses and ponies.

Ring 2: For the more novice riders and horses / ponies.

Classes: 40cm, 50cm, 60cm, 65cm. When the 65cm class has finished there will be a clear round jumping.

The Showing Ring starts at 9.30am

In hand classes first – Best Condition, Veteran -15yrs & over. Coloured and odd colours. Mountain and Moreland horses and ponies. Ridden Classes.

Include Novice Ridden – first time combinations. M&M. Coloureds / Odds. Veterans. Cobs. Family H/P. LR riders. First Ridden & PC Pony.

Hopefully this a nice mix of classes something for every one to enter.

We are lucky to have Pat Blake and Jan Eedle-Wells as our judges for the day.

There will also be in hand and ridden Championships.



HKC Dressage Training

These are brilliant training sessions for riders to have help both warming up and instruction riding the Intro A test in the dressage arena with Anna.
