RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 The decision of the Organisers and Judges is final. They have the right to alter, amend or cancel any part of the competition, or refuse any entry, without stating a reason.
- 2 No entry fee will be refunded unless accompanied by a doctor or vet's certificate.
- 3 All horses and ponies must be 4 years and over in ridden classes.
- 4 All riders must wear a protective helmet manufactured to one of the minimum standards i.e.: PAS 015 (1998) or 2011 provided they have a BSI Kitemark or inspec IC Marked. VG1 01.040:2014-12 with Kite marked or Inspec IC marked. ASTM F1163:2004a or 04a onwards, with Kite Mark. Snell E2001 & Snell E2016 AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) provided they are SAI Global Marked. Riding Hats must be worn at all times with chin straps securely fastened when mounted.
- 5 Correct riding attire must be worn at all time when mounted.
- 6 Dogs are to be kept on leads at all times.
- 7 Litter to be deposited in the bins/bags provided or taken away. No mucking out of trailers or lorries. Leave the field clean and tidy when you go home.
- 8 In the interest of health and safety everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions from organisers and stewards on the day.
- 9 No galloping outside the arenas or in the surrounding area of the field, as there will be people and children on foot.

* The field gate will be opened at 8am on the morning of the show*

Class 13*#Mountain & Moorland – All heights

In hand Championships: for 1st & 2nd placed in classes 10, 11, 12 & 13
Champion & Reserve Champion Rosettes.

Ridden classes. Not before 12 noon.

Class 14# Novice Ridden, - All heights.

Combination not to have won a ridden showing class.

Walk & trot only. Aimed at new combinations or new riders. No Stallions

Class 15*# Mountain and Moorland. – No Lead Reins.

Class 16*#Coloured and odd Coloured – All heights.

Class 17*#Veteran – No lead reins. All heights. Aged 15 years plus.

Class 18*#Cobs. Horses over 148cm/14.2hh. May be hogged or hairy.

Class 19*#Family Horse / Pony – no leading reins, snaffle bridle only.

Suitable to be ridden by all members of the family. No stallions.

Class 20*#Leading Rein Pony – Ponies not exceeding 124cm/12hh.

Riders to be at least 3 but not to have reached 11 on 01/01/18. No stallions

Class 21*#First Ridden Pony – Ponies not exceeding 128cm/12.2hh.

Riders not to have reached their 11th birthday on 01/01/18. No stallions

Class 22*# Pony Club Pony- Not exceeding 153cm/15hh.

To make good all-rounders for Pony Club activities. Snaffles only.

Riders not to have reached their 25th birthday on 01/01/18. No stallions.

GB Rider Summer Showing Championships 2018

The championship is aimed at keen and competitive amateurs.

PRODUCERS ARE EXCLUDED.

Showing Summer Championships will be held at Bury Farm Equestrian Centre on 1st September 2018.

Not eligible for the GB Rider Showing Championships:

Horses & Ponies who have qualified for or competed at HOYS in the years 2015, 2016 or 2017/18.

Unless otherwise specified, classes are open to stallions, mares and geldings, 4 years old and over. Stallions must be handled and ridden by people who have attained their 14th birthday on 1st January 2018. **THEY MUST WEAR A STALLION BADGE**
LEAD REINS ARE ONLY PERMITTED IN THE LEAD REIN CLASSES.

Passports must be available for inspection if asked for by a Judge or official of the show

Qualification can pass down the line as far as 5th place. All riders who want to be eligible to qualify must be GB Rider Members. New Memberships for 2017/18 season are now on sale and can be purchased on line by visiting website: www.gb-rider.com or by ringing our offices on 01234 211245. All members will be sent a qualification card which must be signed in the ring by the Judge.

Many classes at the GB Rider Championships are qualifiers for the Equifest 2018 and Ponies (UK). The veteran classes are qualifiers for the Veteran Horse Society championships. The ridden cob classes are qualifiers for the Traditional Gypsy Cob Society championships.

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE: Please do not enter qualifying classes if your Horse or pony is not eligible. You will be spotted. In 2006, 2007 and 2017, horses and ponies were disqualified which was embarrassing and caused a lot of problems.

TSR Showing Finals

This show is a qualifier for the TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a Final. The Rider/ Handler qualifies and can enter any horse / pony in any number of Finals.

TSR Riders Finals – 1st & 2nd riders qualify and receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals – The two highest placed handlers with a TSR in Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand Class. Handlers **MUST** have their cards signed in the ring by the Judge or Steward, cards are available **FREE** from the TSR website.
