CLASSES - RING 1 (Classes may be divided if sufficient entries) **09:30 am**

- Class 1* **Best Condition**
All heights and ages. Class may be divided into plaited and unplaited.
- Class 2*# **Youngstock: 1, 2 and 3 year olds.**
- Class 3*# **Veteran (in hand)** -For horses (14.2hh and over) and ponies, 15 years plus.
- Class 4*# **Coloured and Odd Coloured (in hand)**- all heights. May be split by colour:
a) for skewbald and piebald horses and ponies only
b) for palominos, duns, appaloosas, roans, spots, paints, creams.

NOT BEFORE 12.00

- Class 5*# In hand **Mountain & Moorland**. May be split by small and large breeds
- Class 6*# **Coloured and Odd Coloured (ridden)**- all heights.
May be split as Class 4.
- Class 7*# **Ridden Mountain & Moorland**. - No lead reins.
May be split between large and small breeds
- Class 8*# **Cobs (ridden)** - Horses over 148cm. May be hogged or hairy.
- Class 9*# **Veteran (ridden)** – No lead reins. For horses and ponies 15 years plus.
- Class 10*# **Family Horse/ Pony** - No lead reins, snaffle bridle only. Suitable to be ridden by all members of the family. No stallions.
- Class 11*# **Leading Rein Pony** - Ponies not exceeding 124cm/12hh. Riders must be at least 3 but not to have reached their 9th birthday on 01/01/18. Rosettes to all entries. No stallions.
- Class 12*# **First Ridden Pony**
Ponies not exceeding 128cm/12.2hh. Riders not to have reached their 11th birthday on 01/01/18. No stallions.
- Class 13*# **Pony Club Pony** - Not exceeding 153cm/15hh
To make good all rounders for all Pony Club activities. Snaffles only.
Riders not to have reached their 25th birthday on 01/01/18. No stallions.

CLASSES - RING 2 **09:30am**

- Class 14# **Minimus Working Hunter Pony**
Not exceeding 14.2hh. Ponies not to have been 1st, 2nd or 3rd in WHP classes
Jumps 2' 0" - 2' 3"

Class 15# **Novice Working Hunter Pony**
Not exceeding 148cm /14.2hh. Ponies not to have been 1st on more than two occasions in WHP classes. Jumps 2' 6" max.

Class 16# **Open Working Hunter Pony**
Not exceeding 148cm /14.2hh. Jumps approx. 2' 9" – 3'0"

CLASSES 14, 15 & 16: WORKING HUNTER PONY CHAMPIONSHIP for 1st & 2nd prizewinners

Class 17# **Novice Ridden, Horse or Pony**
Not to have won a ridden showing class. Walk and trot only.
Aimed at new combinations or new riders. No stallions.

AFTER 12.30pm

Class 18# **Minimus Working Hunter**
Horses exceeding 148cm /14.2hh.. Horses not to have been 1st, 2nd or 3rd in WH classes
Jumps 2' 0" - 2' 3"

Class 19*# **Novice Working Hunter** - Horses exceeding 148cm /14.2hh. Jumps 2' 3 – 2' 6" approx.
Horses not to have won a 2' 9" course or above. No stallions.

Class 20*# **Open Working Hunter**
Horses exceeding 148cm /14.2hh. Jumps approx. 2'9" - 3' 0". No stallions.

CLASSES 18, 19 & 20 : WORKING HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP for 1st & 2nd prizewinners

Class 21*# **Riding Club Horse/Pony** - For horses (exceeding 153cm/15hh) and ponies (not exceeding 153cm/15hh) that make good all rounders for riding club activities. Pony riders to exceed 25 years on 01/01/18. Class may be split. Any suitable bit. No stallions.

Class 22*# **Ridden Hunter** - No stallions, 153cm /15hh and above.

Class 23*# **Rehabilitated Race Horses** – No stallions. Thoroughbreds retired from racing and now retrained. Registered Weatherby's General Studbook or overseas equivalent. Must have raced and can show a race record. Horses 153cm/15hh and over. Will be expected to do a freestyle show. Blemishes not considered. Rider must have reached 17th birthday on 1st Jan 2018. Open to mares, geldings 4 years old and over. Judge will not ride.

PASSPORTS MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION IF ASKED FOR BY A JUDGE OR OFFICIAL OF THE SHOW

C&T RIDER Showing Championships

The Championship is aimed at keen and competitive amateurs. PRODUCERS ARE EXCLUDED. Summer Championships will be held over two days, 1ST – 2ND September 2018 at Bury Farm Equestrian Centre.

Not eligible for the C&T Rider Championships:

Horses and Ponies who have qualified for or competed at HOYS in the years 2015, 2016 or 2017/8.

Unless otherwise specified, classes are open to stallions, mares and geldings, 4 years old and over. Stallions must be handled and ridden by people who have attained their 14th birthday on 1st January 2018. LEAD REINS ARE ONLY PERMITTED IN THE LEAD REIN CLASSES.

Passports must be available for inspection if asked for by a judge or official of the show.

Qualification can pass down the line, as far as 5th place. All riders who want to be eligible to qualify must be CT Rider Members. New memberships for the 2017/18 season are now on sale and can be purchased on line by visiting www.chilternrider.com or by ringing the CTR offices on 01234 211245

All members will be sent a qualification card which they must get signed in the ring by the judge.

Many classes at the CTR Championships will be qualifiers for the Equifest 2018 and Ponies (UK). The Veteran classes are the qualifiers for The Veteran Horse Society championship. The ridden cob classes are qualifiers for the traditional Gypsy Cob Society championships.

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE: Please do not enter qualifying classes if your horse or pony is not eligible. You will get spotted. In 2006, 2007 and 2017, horses or ponies were disqualified which was embarrassing and caused a lot of problems.

TSR Showing Finals

This show is a qualifier for the TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals – 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals – The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

TSR Medal Awards – TSR members can collect qualification cards & signatures and redeem for a TSR Medal see TSR website for details.

BSHA Grass Roots Champs – With a TSR qualification card you can also enter the BSHA Grass Roots Champs in Sept at Addington Equestrian Centre – You do not have to be a BSHA member to qualify or enter the final. See www.britishshowhorse.org
